Funding to support innovative online food pantry, My Pantry Express

Geneva, IL (June 19, 2023) – <u>Northern Illinois Food Bank</u> announced today it received a grant from Bayer Fund, a philanthropic of arm of Bayer in the U.S. This grant will be used towards building a better future by supporting Northern Illinois Food Bank's <u>My Pantry Express</u> program.

My Pantry Express is an innovative online food pantry program that alleviates the stigma of having to ask for help, by providing an anonymous, normalized grocery order. Bayer Fund is a long-standing supporter of Northern Illinois Food Bank and a funder of My Pantry Express since it began in 2019.
