The Illinois Tollway's **I-PASS Assist program** is now providing more assistance than ever, helping income-eligible individuals and families realize the benefits of I-PASS.

### I-Pass Assist program benefits:

- The Same Benefits of I-Pass
- Passenger vehicles save 50% on tolls
- Easily manage vehicles and travel costs
- Seamless travel on the Illinois Tollway
- Open an account with as little as \$4 in prepaid tolls
- No transponder deposit required
- Automatic account replenishments as low as \$4
- **I-PASS Assist customers may be eligible to have invoice fees dismissed once enrolled**

### Qualifications

To be eligible for enrollment in I-PASS Assist, household income must not exceed 250% of Federal Poverty Guidelines as verified by the Illinois Department of Revenue or qualified by the Illinois Department of Human Services for cash and food assistance programs.
