

### RACE DAY REGISTRATION

### **DITCHING DISPOSABLE**

• Our Golden Grocer Sponsor, ALDI, and the Food Bank have a shared vision in creating efficiency and reducing waste. As we strive to reduce our race day waste, we are happy to share that ALDI is providing the first 1,500 registered participants with a resuable HydraPak Speed Cup to use on and off the Fight Hunger course. The cups will be distributed at packet pick-up. Be sure to remember the reusable cup if you're picking up packets on 4/25.

# HOW TO CARRY A SPEEDCUP



ALDI

The SpeedCup was designed to be lightweight, easy to hold and collapsible so it can be tucked almost anywhere.



#### PACK

Collapse or fold the cup and tuck it in your short, belt or pack pocket.



#### CLIP

Use a mini carabiner to clip the cup to your belt, pack or bra strap.



#### STASH

Tuck in arm sleeve, compression shorts or stash in your sports bra.



#### HOLD

Use the finger loop to carry the cup in your hand

# 5K / FUN RUN COURSE

- The Fight Hunger 5K is a certified course and participants will be chip-timed. The Fun Run route is approximately 1.2 miles and begins at the same location as the 5K. This route does not cross Jorie Blvd. and will finish in the Post-Race Festival (near mile 3 on the 5K route). Please visit www.solvehungertoday.org/fighthunger if you'd like to view the certified route map.
- The 5K route is considered a trail run. Although most of the route is on a paved path, there is
  a small section where participants will be running on gravel. Please be mindful of uneven
  terrain and potholes.



# **ON COURSE SUPPORT**

- A water station will be available at the half way point, provided by the Golden Grocer Sponsor, ALDI.
- Our volunteer Course Marshalls will be providing encourgment and cheering you on!

#### **AWARDS & TIMING**

- 5K participants will be chip-timed and awards will be given based on the times recorded by Lakeshore Athletic Services.
- Awards will be presented to the top male and female overall finishers in each designated category (Ages: 14 & Under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80 & Over).
- In-Person Awards will be announced during the Post-Race Festival on the stage at 10:30 AM.
- Participants who complete the Fun Run will receive a finisher ribbon. The Fun Run is not timed.


# **ENJOYING THE EVENT**
