## Northern Illinois Food Bank's 11<sup>th</sup> Annual A Taste That Matters Raises over \$375,000 for Hunger Relief

Over 500 guests enjoyed an evening filled with fun, food, and auction.

Geneva, IL (June 30, 2023) – Northern Illinois Food Bank is pleased to announce the 11<sup>th</sup> annual A Taste That Matters fundraiser and culinary event, presented by Jewel-Osco, raised more than \$375,000. Northern Illinois Food Bank provides 80 million meals a year to neighbors throughout 13 counties throughout suburban and rural Northern Illinois. Proceeds from the event will benefit the Food Bank's network of 900 food pantries, soup kitchens and feeding programs.

The event was held on June 22nd at Drury Lane Theatre and Events, 100 Drury Ln, Oakbrook Terrace, IL from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Over 500 attendees enjoyed an extensive silent auction, open bar, and food tastings from dozens of local chefs and vendors. The evening included remarks from Julie Yurko, President and CEO, Northern Illinois Food Bank, Mike Withers, President of Jewel-Osco, and Tom Hong, Retail Relations Specialist, Northern Illinois Food Bank.

This year marks the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Northern Illinois Food Bank. A special <u>video</u> about the Food Bank's history was featured during the event.
