PRE-EVENT PACKET PICK-UP

RACE DAY PACKET PICK-UP & REGISTRATION

- If you have already picked up your participant packet, you do NOT need to check-in on event day. Please bring your race bib, safety pins, and reusable cup to the event.
- If you did not pick up your packet on May 1, please arrive at least 30 minutes before your start time to allow time for check-in and to make your way to start line.
- Race day registration is \$50 at the Packet Pick-Up / Registration Tents.

10:30 AM: Awards Ceremony



PARKING

- Parking is free for Fight Hunger participants. Enter Cantigny Park from Winfield Road and proceed to the South parking lots. Please allow at least 30 minutes to make your way to the Start Line.
- Participants who have fundraised \$1,000+ will receive a VIP Parking Pass via email.

DITCHING DISPOSABLE

- Presenting Sponsor, ALDI, and the Food Bank have a shared vision in creating efficiency and reducing waste. As we strive to reduce our race day waste, we are happy to share that at packet pick-up, ALDI is providing the first 2,000 registered participants with a reusable, collapsible cup to use at the 1/2 way water station and finish line. Be sure to remember to bring your cup if you're picking up packets on 5/1.



PARTICIPANT PERKS



- A water cup fill station will be available near the half way point and finish line. Participants are encouraged to bring and use their reusable water cup.

AWARDS & TIMING

- 10K and 5K participants will be chip-timed and awards will be given based on the times recorded by J3 Timing Services.
- Awards will be presented to the top male and female overall finishers in each designated category (Ages: 9 & Under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80 & Over).
- Fundraising Awards: the top three fundraising teams (most fundraised)
- Largest Team Award (most team members)
- The Team Spirit Award will recognize the team that creates awareness for the cause based on costumes, team name, t-shirts, props, enthusiasm, songs, chants, etc. Have fun and be creative, and maybe you'll go home with bragging rights!
- Prizes and awards are based on team donations only, not registration fees. Awards are based on team totals as of Friday, May 2nd, at 5pm.
- In-Person Awards will be announced during the Post-Race Festival on the stage at 10:30 AM.
- The Fun Run is not timed and no awards will be announced.


